Adverbs - Forms

<p>Es gibt natürliche Adverbien</p> <p>und solche, die von Adjektiven abgeleitet werden. Die Ableitung geschieht durch das Anhängen der Endung <i>-ly</i> oder in einigen Fällen durch Anhängen der Endung <i>-ally</i>.</p>	<p><i>here, there, yesterday, tomorrow, often, always, almost, very, perhaps etc.</i></p> <p><i>quickly, happily, unfortunately, terribly, really, carefully, frantically etc.</i></p>

Hier sind einige Besonderheiten zu beachten!

Adjektiv	Adverb	Besonderheiten
<i>quick</i>	<i>quickly</i>	
<i>easy</i>	<i>easily</i>	-y am Ende wird meist zu -i- aber: <i>shyly, dryly</i>
<i>careful</i>	<i>carefully</i>	-l- am Ende wird verdoppelt
<i>simple</i>	<i>simply</i>	-le- am Ende nach Konsonant entfällt
<i>true</i>	<i>truly</i>	unbetontes -e- am Ende entfällt aber: <i>extremely</i>
<i>fanatic</i>	<i>fanatically</i>	nach -ic am Ende steht -ally aber: <i>publicly</i>
<i>friendly</i>	<i>in a friendly way</i>	-ly am Ende des Adjektivs → keine Adverbform
<i>difficult</i>	<i>with difficulty</i>	→ keine Adverbform
<i>good</i>	<i>well</i>	<i>He is a good boy. - He plays football very well.</i>

Gleiche Form → gleiche Bedeutung!!!

<p><i>fast</i> <i>far</i> <i>fine</i> <i>early</i> <i>daily, weekly etc.</i> und einige andere</p>	<p><i>fast</i> <i>far</i> <i>fine</i> <i>early</i> <i>daily, weekly etc.</i></p>	<p><i>He has got a fast car. - He always drives fast.</i> <i>He lives on the far side of the city. - He has gone too far.</i> <i>This is a fine meal. - The espresso machine is working fine again.</i> <i>We had an early breakfast. - He always comes early to our meetings.</i> <i>He didn't get his daily newspaper. - He likes to read his newspaper daily.</i></p>

<p><i>hard</i> (hart) <i>fair</i> (fair) <i>pretty</i> (ziemlich)</p>	<p><i>hardly</i> (kaum) <i>fairly</i> (ziemlich) <i>prettily</i> (hübsch)</p>	<p><i>She is working hard. - She hardly worked last week.</i> <i>This is a fair offer. - This offer is fairly expensive.</i> <i>He is pretty clever at French. - His hair is prettily cut.</i></p>
