

Wortstellung von Adverbien und adverbialen Gruppen der Häufigkeit

Position of Adverbs and Adverbial Phrases of Frequency

Adverb bzw. adverbiale Gruppe	Position	Beispiele
<p>- der unbestimmten Häufigkeit</p> <p>Adverbien: <i>always, often, sometimes, usually, never, ever etc.</i></p> <p>Adverbiale Gruppen: <i>in general, by habit etc.</i></p>	<p>Adverbien können immer stehen nach den Formen von to be (<i>am, are, is, was, were</i>), nach dem Hilfsverb have, can etc. bzw. vor dem Vollverb, also in der Mitte.</p> <p>Adverbiale Gruppen stehen meist am Anfang des Satzes (manchmal am Ende), nie in der Mitte.</p>	<p><i>She always has porridge for breakfast. He usually has coffee with his breakfast. Have you ever been to Scotland? They never drink alcohol. I sometimes spend too much money on shoes.</i></p> <p><i>In general there are a lot of people in the park. By habit he took a walk in the afternoon.</i></p>
<p>- der bestimmten Häufigkeit</p> <p>Adverbien: <i>daily, weekly, once etc.</i></p> <p>Adverbiale Gruppen: <i>three times, every day, twice a week, each time etc.</i></p>	<p>Adverbien und adverbiale Gruppen stehen normalerweise am Ende des Satzes. (auch am Satzanfang möglich → Betonung, Kontrast)</p>	<p><i>The plane flies to Heathrow daily. She goes to her yoga practice weekly. He meets his friends twice a week. (Each time I see her, she is working in the garden.)</i></p>
