Das Stützwort **one / ones** dient dazu, ein zählbares Nomen, das nicht wiederholt werden soll, zu vermeiden. Es steht nach

- **the, this, that**

- nach Adjektiven

*Oh, look at these handbags. I like **the one** in the middle.
I have two watches for you. **This one** is cheap and **that one** is expensive.
These oranges are sweeter than **the ones** we had yesterday.*

*Shall we take a large bottle of wine or a **small one**.
I have got two sorts of marmalade, a **sweet one** and a **bitter one**. (sort not marmalade)*

One / ones kann, muss aber nicht stehen nach

- **these / those,**

- einem Komparativ oder Superlativ,

- einer Ordnungszahl,

- **which.**

*There are a lot of different sweets in the box. Let's take some of **these (ones)** and some of **those (ones)**.*

*Look at that cat. It is the **most beautiful (one)** I've ever seen.*

*Peter was **the first (one)** to have a new bike.*

*I have got two sorts of marmalade. **Which (one)** do you want?*

Das Stützwort **one / ones** ersetzt keine nicht zählbaren Nomen. I.d.R. werden diese wiederholt.

Ebenso steht das Stützwort **one / ones** nicht nach

- **Grundzahlen**

- **einigen Mengenangaben (many, few, a few, some, any, all)**

- **anstelle eines Possessivpronomens.**

*If there's no **French wine** left, we will have the **Spanish wine**.*

*How many handbags have you got, Sheila? - **Three**.*

*Are there some sweets left? - Not **many**, if you want **some**, I'll give you **a few**.*

*Is this your skateboard? - No, it's not **mine**, it's **Billy's**.*
